Gregory Hunter Wins ACA Distinguished Service Award

Gregory Hunter was recently awarded the Distinguished Service Award by the Academy of Certified Archivists (ACA) at the association's Annual Business Meeting in Washington, DC.

Dr. Hunter, who was the first president of ACA in 1989, is the Director of the Doctor of Philosophy in Information Studies and the Certificate Program in Archives and Records Management at LIU Post in Brookville, NY. He has been a professor in the Palmer School of Library and Information Science since 1990.

As ACA's first president, Dr. Hunter helped ACA develop into a full-fledged nationally recognized certification body for professional archivists. There are now over 1,200 certified archivists in the United States and throughout the world.

In addition to being a Certified Archivist, Dr. Hunter is also a Certified Records Manager, as well as a fellow of the Society of American Archivists, which has honored two of his books with awards. Since 2012, Dr. Hunter has been the editor of *The American Archivist*, SAA's peer-reviewed journal.
